

Explanation of ISWS Conformation Classes

Dogs are judged first, followed by bitches, preceded or followed by various non-Regular classes. Winners of each Regular Class compete for: Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Bitch. Winners dog & Winners Bitch are eligible for Best of Breed Competition. Winners of Best Veteran Dog, & Best Veteran Bitch are eligible for Best of Breed Competition. Winners of 3-6 Month Puppy, Altered, Stud Dog, and Brood Bitch **do not** compete in Best of Breed.

Age of an eligible dog shall be calculated up to and inclusive of the day of the show

Below are descriptions of all of the classes. Use them to determine where you wish to enter your dog(s).

* indicates a non-regular class, no ISWS championship points awarded from these Classes

**Please note you may only enter in ONE class for each dog, with the exception of Stud Dogs and Brood Bitches, which *may* also be entered in regular classes, veteran, or altered, and their progeny which *must* be entered in one of the regular classes.

***As a way to honor the foundational pillars of the dogs showing today, we are offering **FREE stud dog and brood bitch entries**.

3–6 Month Puppy* — For puppies (except ISWS champions) that are at least 3 but less than 6 months old on the date of the show. (First place in this class will compete for Best Puppy in Show.)

6–12 Month Puppy — For puppies (except ISWS champions) that are at least 6 but less than 12 months old on the date of the show. (First place in this class will compete for Best Puppy in Show and Winners.)

****ONLY First place in each of these classes; non-regular 3-6, 6-12 puppy classes, will compete for Best Puppy in Show. ****

12-18 Month — This class is for dogs (except ISWS champions) that are at least 12 but less than 18 months old on the date of the show. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Bred by Exhibitor — The Bred-By Exhibitor class has the following requirements:

- Six months of age or older on the date of the show
- Not a champion of record in ISWS on the date of the show
- Must be Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record on the date of the show
- Handler must be a breeder of record and an owner/co-owner of the entered dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog becomes eligible there are no handler restrictions. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

American Bred — For all silken (except ISWS champions) 6 months of age or older that have been both bred and whelped in the United States of America. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Field Performance Champion — For all silken, except ISWS champions, that have earned a performance championship for straight racing, oval racing, lure coursing or open field coursing. Proof of a championship title for straight racing (ISWS or LGRA), oval racing (ISWS or NOTRA), lure coursing (ISWS or ASFA), or open field coursing (NOFCA or other recognized open field coursing association) must be submitted with the show entry. A copy of the championship certificate or a printout from the website of the appropriate organization showing that the dog has earned a championship will suffice as proof of championship title. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Open — For any silken 6 months of age or older. (First place in this class will compete for Winners.)

Best of Breed — For all ISWS Champions of record (to be joined by Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best Veteran Dog, and Best Veteran Bitch).

Veterans* — For all silken 7 years of age and over. Neutered or spayed dogs are allowed in this class. (First place in this class will compete for Best Veteran and both Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch winners will compete in Best of Breed.)

Altered Novice* — This class is for all altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over that have not yet won:

- 3 first-place prizes against competition in the Altered Novice Class or any ISWS, UKC or ICKC class
- 3 or more points towards their Altered ISWS championship
- or have earned a championship from another venue (UKC or ICKC) prior to the date of the closing of entries.

Altered Open* — For all altered dogs (except ISWS or Altered ISWS champions) 6 months of age or over.

Best of Altered* — For all Altered ISWS Champions of record, Altered Winners Dog, and Altered Winners Bitch.

Stud Dog* — Each entry shall consist of a stud dog with 2 of his progenies. The stud dog must be shown in the ring with his progeny. The stud dog may be neutered, but the progeny must be intact. The stud dog's owner is not required to own the progeny. All progeny shown in this class must be entered in 1 of the regular classes. The winner of this class is not eligible for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed competition.

Brood Bitch* — Each entry shall consist of a brood bitch with 2 of her progenies. The brood bitch must be shown in the ring with her progeny. The brood bitch may be spayed, but the progeny must be intact. The brood bitch's owner is not required to own the progeny. All progeny shown in this class must be entered in 1 of the regular classes. The winner of this class is not eligible for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed competition.

Show Entry & Fees

This specialty is hosted in conjunction with the [IABCA's 2024 Rocky Mountain Sieger](#), and takes the place of IABCA show 2 on Saturday. Silken windhound exhibitors are welcome and encouraged to enter IABCA show 1 on Saturday, as well as the Sunday shows, but **will not** compete in the IABCA show 2 on Saturday. Silken Windhounds entered in show 2 Saturday will be entered to compete in the specialty show, run concurrently with IABCA show 2. Registration with IABCA is **not** required to compete in the specialty.

Please review how to enter this specialty.

****Silkens must be entered through both IABCA AND SWARM****

Payment for the specialty is processed through IABCA, and class entries are received through SWARM. A SWARM entry form without IABCA payment confirmation **will not** be valid, and vice versa.

All entry forms must be signed and must include the Show Entry Agreement; otherwise the entry cannot be accepted and will be returned. All entries will be put in the catalog exactly as they are listed on the entry form. Owners are responsible for errors on the entry forms. Please verify the accuracy of your entry information by using the ISWS pedigree database.

Entries Must Be Received by September 27, 2024 at 11:59 PM Mountain Time.

THERE WILL BE NO DAY OF ENTRIES (ISWS show rules, chapter 6, section 1).

After the close of entries, no entries may be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, completed, or signed, and no entry fees will be refunded.

Class corrections, as allowed by ISWS show rules, must be received in writing by the secretary at least one half hour before the start of the show. The show secretary and show committee have the sole discretion to make an informed decision regarding any class corrections. Owners bear full responsibility for errors in the entry form, regardless of who made such errors. A dog shown in a class for which it is ineligible will forfeit all wins and prizes associated with such win but will be considered as having competed for the purpose of counting points available. No entry fees will be refunded for such errors.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I agree to hold the International Silken Windhound Association (ISWS), the Silken Windhound Association of the Rocky Mountains (SWARM), show volunteers, judges, secretaries, stewards, the owner/lessee of the premises, and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this event while in or about the premises or grounds, and I personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim. I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to my dog(s) or dogs in my care. Additionally, I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused.
